Robin



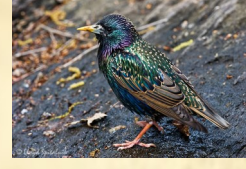
Common gull

Carrion Crow



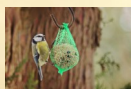
Magpie
